Dear Certifying Official:

VA received your request for the 35 percent reporting exemption of the 85/15 percent ratio on May 28, 2025. The *35 Percent Exemption Request From 85/15 Reporting Requirement*, VA Form 22-10216, reports your total VA student enrollment as .87%.

Because your school's VA beneficiary student percentage is 35 percent or less of the total student population and your school is approved under 38 U.S.C. § 3672 and/or 38 U.S.C. § 3675, all approved programs are exempt from 85/15 computation and reporting requirements for quarters, semesters, terms, or enrollment periods beginning on or after the date of this letter.

This 35 percent reporting exemption remains in effect for 24 months from the date of this letter, at which time you must submit an updated VA Form 22-10216 showing 35 percent or less VA beneficiary students to maintain the exemption.

- 1. Schools organized on a term, quarter, or semester basis must submit the exemption request no later than 30 days after the beginning of first calendar term for which the school wishes the exemption to apply.
- 2. All other schools must submit the exemption request within 30 days of the beginning of the quarter for which the school wishes the exemption to apply.

IMPORTANT:

Your school must maintain records of 85/15 computations for any periods not covered by the 35 percent exemption and be prepared to provide them upon request during compliance surveys covering such periods. All requests must be provided via the Education File Upload Portal: Education File Upload Portal .
